Schevinin shared that attendance is better and if the pace continues Prairie will be on track to meet its attendance goal. Goal is less than 30% of chronic absences with an attendance of 95%.</p> <p>K. Schevenin noted that families sign both the compact for DI and the parent compact. Asked, how can we support families to support their student's progress throughout the year?</p> <p>Delgadillo suggested the next round of parent conferences include a reminder of the importance of attendance.</p>

Price shared that classes with the best attendance will win the teacher lunch for the next three weeks.</p> <p>K. Schevenin asked how will independent study contracts impact the competition? Prairie has one of the largest populations of migrant students and the district office will approve 30 days rather than the 20 days that is typical.</p> <p>G. Linares asked if Migrant Ed students could have access to the Flex Program to support those students.</p> <p>C. Price replied that we aren't really allowed to do that and that it impacts attendance.</p> <p>K. Schevenin shared that there is a Migrant Ed TOSA who advocate for our migrant students and families.</p> <p>J. Sais suggested that the Family Compact Incorporate the PRIDE (prepared, respectful, integrity, determination, empathy) into the different parts. The council agreed.</p> <p>K. Schevenin proposed adding a bullet for families to create and use an Aeries Parent Portal account and to stay informed about updates sent via Parent Square.</p> <p>J. Sais would also like teachers to have access to signing up parents in Aeries and parent square.</p> <p>K. Schevenin updated the meeting times for the school site council and PTA in the Parent Compact.</p> <p>Improved responses in California Healthy Kids Survey last spring.</p> <p>There is a need to streamline the grade process and align it with Aeries so that multiple teachers can input grades for their progress for a single student.</p>
