Average rating on self-reflection tool was 5.57. The goal is to increase by 10% on the self-reflection tool. There will be a team sent to the institute and teachers will change which will impact ongoing implementation.</p> <p>Recap:</p> <p>Next year pull out reading intervention will occur primarily in first and second grade.</p> <p>PLC trainings will be covered by the district which will allow funds to be reallocated to sending a team to CABA next year.</p> <p>The plan to retain teachers will be directed to coaching teachers between Mr. Delgadillo and Ms. Thompson to coach the 6th grade team and the 5th grade team once a month together Both teachers have been mentors to new teachers. ½ of 5th and ¾ of 6th grade positions have yet to be filled, but it seems like a district wide problem.</p> <p>C. Minor asked about the amount of money directed at Goal 2 vs. Goal 3 given the percent of student population that identify as EL.</p> <p>J. Delgadillo noted that supporting the lower grade levels will help minimize the needs of older grade students.</p>

			<p>C. Minor asked about how those student needs will be met over the next two years.</p> <p>K. Schevenin noted that the Tier 1 supports around coaching, PROMESA and PLC will be really focusing on providing best practices at Tier 1 for all students.</p> <p>The goal is that PLC teams identifying what students needs to learn, determining if they've learned it, and what teachers will be able to do if they haven't or have exceeded the learning goals.</p> <p>B. Ibarra noted that parents have asked for the music program at the elementary to be more culturally relevant.</p> <p>K. Schevenin noted that more students have been engaged in Youtha Advisory meetings.</p> <p>K. Schevenin shared that Leadership decided that there will be perfect attendance recognition, students who were reclassified were recognized by the district. This year, teachers will choose 5 students based on Puma Pride (prepared, respectful, integrity, determination,</p> <p>Motion to approve SPSA made by D. Decker, seconded by M.Davis.
